

Attributing Documentary Australia

As part of the terms and conditions accepted by filmmakers when applying to raise philanthropic funds through Documentary Australia, completed films must attribute Documentary Australia in their documentary's credits.

The suggested wording is:

"Financed with the assistance of Documentary Australia".

If the Documentary Australia Grant is equal to or greater than government (including screen agency) funding, in addition to the above, you must provide a presentation credit of "In association with Documentary Australia..." with equal prominence to those other government or screen funding agencies

These attributions must also include Documentary Australia's Logo. In this pack you will find a range of our logos, in both black and white, for your use.

Logo Use Guidelines:

- The logo used must be clearly distinguishable from the background.
- The logo's colour should not be altered.
- There should be sufficient space when placing the logo to maintain its legibility.
- The logo should not be stretched or distorted.
- No elements should be added to the logo (i.e. additional images or text).
- We recommend using Din as the complimentary text to the logo.
